AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring buildings and facilities to indicate the location of automated external defibrillators at the entrance of such buildings or facilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 3000-b of the public health law is amended by adding a new paragraph (f) to read as follows:
(F) THE PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATION PROVIDER SHALL POST A SIGN OR NOTICE AT THE MAIN ENTRANCE TO THE FACILITY OR BUILDING IN WHICH THE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IS STORED, INDICATING THE LOCATION WHERE ANY SUCH AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IS STORED OR MAINTAINED IN SUCH BUILDING OR FACILITY ON A REGULAR BASIS.

S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law.
